

# ‘Ελληνικές Διατριβές σε ’Αγγλικά Πανεπιστήμια

Συλλογή-έπιμέλεια: Ροῦσσος Σ. Κούνδουρος

Τά Σύγχρονα Θέματα, δημοσιεύουν σ' αὐτό τό τεῦχος γιά πρώτη φορά στήν πορεία τοῦ περιοδικοῦ ἀλλά ἵσως καὶ γενικότερα στήν ‘Ελλάδα, κατάλογο ὅλων τῶν ‘Ελληνικῶν διατριβῶν, πού ύποβλήθηκαν στά Βρετανικά καὶ Ἰρλανδικά Πανεπιστήμια. Τή συστηματική αὐτῆς δουλειά τήν ἔκανε ὁ ἐρευνητής Ροῦσσος Κούνδουρος, ἀφού χρειάστηκε νά καλύψει τό διάδασμα πάνω ἀπό 120.00 τίτλους διατριβῶν.

Οἱ βασικοί λόγοι πού μᾶς ὥθησαν στή δημοσίευση αὐτῆς τῆς δουλειᾶς δημοσιεύονται, γιά τεχνικούς λόγους, στή σελίδα 66.

## ΠΡΟΛΕΓΟΜΕΝΑ

Ο σκοπός αὐτῆς τῆς ἐρευνας ἦταν ἡ συλλογή διδακτορικῶν διατριβῶν καὶ ἄλλων σημαντικῶν μεταπτυχιακῶν ἐργασιῶν γιά τήν ‘Ελλάδα πού ύποβλήθηκαν στά Βρετανικά καὶ Ἰρλανδικά πανεπιστήμια ἀπό τό τελευταῖο τέταρτο τοῦ προηγούμενου αἰώνα μέχρι πρίν ἔξει χρόνια. Πολύ σύντομα θά μπορέσω νά παρουσιάσω καὶ τίς διατριβές τῶν τελευταίων αὐτῶν χρόνων. Ισως νά ἦταν χρήσιμο νά ἐνημερώνεται ὁ κατάλογος αὐτός κάθε δύο-τρία χρόνια, ὥστε οἱ ἐρευνητές νά κρατιώνται σέ συνεχῆ ἐπαφή μέ τό ‘Ελληνοκεντρικό τμῆμα τοῦ ἀγγλικοῦ ἐπιστημονικοῦ προβληματισμοῦ.

Δέν περιλαμβάνονται ἐργασίες πού ύποβλήθηκαν ὡς δευτερεύοντα συμπληρωματική ὑποχρέωση, συνήθως μετά ἀπό γραπτές ἔξετάσεις γιά τήν ἀπόκτηση κάποιουν ἀνώτερου μεταπτυχιακοῦ διπλώματος. Παρατίθενται μόνο ἐκείνες πού ἡ ἀπονομὴ τοῦ διπλώματος στηρίχηται ἀποκλειστικά σέ βαθύτερη ἐπιστημονική ἐρευνα.

Συνολικά ἡ συλλογή ἔχει περνᾶ τούς χίλιους τίτλους πού χωρίζονται σέ δύο ἐνότητες. ‘Η πρώτη ἐνότητα ἀρχίζει ἀπό τό 1874 -δόποτε ἔγκριθηκε ἡ παλιότερη διατριβή πού μπόρεσα νά ἐντοπίσω- ὡς τό 1950. ‘Η δεύτερη ἐνότητα ἀναφέρεται, στήν περίοδο ἀπό 1950 ὧς 1974. Λίγες μόνο ἐργασίες τοῦ 1975 ἔχουν περιληφθεῖ. Γιά λόγους πού σχετίζονται μέ τήν κατάταξη τῶν πηγῶν δλες οἱ χρονολογίες πρέπει νά διαβαστοῦν κατά προσέγγιση ἔτους περίπου. Οἱ διατριβές τῆς πρώτης ἐνότητας παρατίθενται σύμφωνα μέ τό χρόνο ἔγκρισής τους π.χ. 1874. Στή δεύτερη ἐνότητα οἱ διατριβές παρατίθενται κατά τόν ἀκαδη-

μαϊκό χρόνο ἔγκρισής τους, π.χ. 1951-1952. Αὐτή ἡ διαφοροποίηση δφεύλεται στίς ἀνόμωις καταχωρήσεις τῶν πηγῶν πού χρησιμοποιήθηκαν. Θά παρατηρήσει ἐπίσης ὁ ἀναγνώστης ὅτι οἱ τίτλοι καὶ ἡ σειρά τῶν διαφόρων μερῶν τῆς πρώτης ἐνότητας δέν συμπίπτει μέ τούς ἀντίστοιχους τῆς δεύτερης. Αὐτό δφεύλεται σέ δικούς μον πειραματισμούς γιά μά «ἐπιτυχέστερη» ταξινόμηση. Θά πρέπει ἐδῶ νά ἀναφερθεῖ ὅτι ἡ δημοσίευση τῆς δεύτερης ἐνότητας προηγήθηκε χρονικά τῆς πρώτης καὶ ἔχει ἡδη κυκλοφορήσει σέ ἓν εἰδικό μωκρό τόμο ἀπό τό Γραφείο Τύπου τῆς ‘Ελληνικῆς Πρεσβείας Λονδίνου μέ τίτλο ‘On Greece And Cyprus Theses Index In Britain’. ‘Η πρώτη ἐνότητα δλοκληρώθηκε πρόσφατα καὶ θά κυκλοφορήσει σύντομα ἀπό τόν ἴδιο φορέα στήν ‘Αγγλία. ‘Η συνολική παρουσίαση καὶ τῶν δύο ἐνοτήτων ἀπ’ τά Σύγχρονα Θέματα είναι ἡ πρώτη στήν ‘Ελλάδα.

Γιά νά γίνει δυνατή ἡ συλλογή χρειάστηκε στήν ἀρχῇ νά ἐντοπιστοῦν διάφορες πηγές καὶ μετά νά διαβαστοῦν συνολικά πάνω ἀπό ἑκατόν εἴκοσι χιλιάδες τίτλοι διατριβῶν ἀπό τούς δποίους ἐπιλέγηκαν ἐκεῖνοι πού θεώρησα πάς ταίριαζαν στό θέμα «έλληνικές διατριβές». Καὶ λέροντας ‘Ελλάδα στήν περίπτωση αὐτή ἐνοοῦμε μά ἰδεολογική κατηγορία καὶ δχι ἔνα χώρο συγκεκριμένων γεωγραφικῶν συντεταγμένων. Αὐτό γίνεται πιό καθαρό ἀν σκεφθεῖ κανείς ὅτι ὁ ἐννοιολογικός ἡ γεωγραφικός προσδιορισμός τῆς ρωμασύνης είναι πολύ δύσκολος ἰδιαίτερα σέ περιόδους δπως ἀρχαία ‘Ελλάδα, ἔλληνιστικοί χρόνοι, βυζάντιο, τουρκοκρατία, ἀλλά καὶ μεταγενέστερα.

‘Ομως, ἡ γραμμή γιά τό τί είναι έλληνικό καὶ τί δχι κάποιον ἐπρεπε νά χαραχτεῖ μέ κάποιο βαθμό αὐθαιρεσίας, δπως δλες

οι γραμμές, άλλα, έλπιζω, μέ σο γινόταν λιγότερες άνακριβεις.

Οι τομεῖς πού πραγματεύονται οι διατριβές είναι τόσο ποικίλοι δοση και ή φαντασία τών έρευνητών απ' τούς πιό προφανείς όπως, φιλοσοφία, λογοτεχνία, άρχαιολογία, μυθολογία, ιστορία, νομικά, άρχιτεκτονική, έμποριο, γεωγραφία, τέχνη, άνθρωπολογία, και οίκονομικά, ώς νομοσιατολογία, ιατρική, μαθηματικά, άστρονομία, γεωλογία, θεατρολογία, άλχημια, μαγεία, ψυχανάλυση, έκπαιδευση, κοινωνιολογία, φεμνιστικά θέματα και άλλα. Ο λόγος πού δέν συντάχτηκε ένα θεματικό ένυρετήριο ήταν ότι στήν 'Αγγλία, και γιά τά χρόνια πού μλαμε, δέν έκδιδονταν κάθε τόσο περιλήψεις διατριβών όπως π.χ. στήν 'Αμερική. Έτσι διένιαφερόμενος καλείται νά συμπεράνει τό περιεχόμενο μᾶς διατριβής από τόν τίτλο της. Συνακόλουθα θά ήταν παρακινδυνεύμενο νά έτυχειρούσα μία θεματική ταξινόμηση βασιζόμενος μόνο στόν τίτλο. Γιά τόν ίδιο λόγο, δέν συμπεριλήφθηκαν διατριβές πού ή άλητηκότητά τους δέν συναγόταν από τόν τίτλο τους. 'Αναπόφευκτες λοιπόν έλλειψεις, πού μπορεί έπισης νά δφείλονται σέ μή πληρότητα τών πηγών ή σέ πιθανές άβλεψιες, θά ήταν χρήσιμο νά μού γίνονταν γνωστές ώστε νά περιληφθούν σέ μεταγενέστερες παρουσιάσεις.

'Αντίγραφα διατριβών (φωτοαντίγραφα ή μικροφόλμις) βρίσκονται στή δανειστική βιβλιοθήκη τού Πανεπιστημίου πού τίς ένέκρινε ή στήν κεντρική 'Αγγλική δανειστική βιβλιοθήκη (British Lending Library). Βέβαια, άν κάποιος χρειάζεται νά τίς διαβάσει στήν 'Ελλάδα δέν είμαι σίγουρος γιά τό πώς και άν θά μπορούσε νά τίς προμηθευτεί. 'Ιως τό Βρετανικό Συμβούλιο νά είναι σέ θέση νά βοηθήσει. 'Ιως πάλι κάποιο Πανεπιστήμιο ή 'Ιδρυμα Έρευνών ή ή ίδια ή 'Ακαδημία νά μπορούσαν νά δργανώσουν μία ύπηρεσία δανεισμοῦ διατριβών από δλο τόν κόσμο. Νομίζω ότι μέ τήν 'Αγγλία και τήν 'Αμερική τουλάχιστον, αντό θά ήταν πολύ ενκολο μά και έκει ύπάρχουν από δ, τι ξέρω καλά δργανωμένες δανειστικές ύπηρεσίες. Κάτι πιό φιλόδοξο θά ήταν νά φτιάξουμε μά βιβλιοθήκη ξένων διατριβών γιά τήν 'Ελλάδα σέ έναν από τούς παραπάνω δργανισμούς. Σέ όποιαδήποτε από αυτές τίς προσπάθειες θά ημουν διατεθειμένος νά βοηθήσω πρακτικά.

Κάθε ένότητα τής συλλογής χωρίζεται σέ διάφορα μέρη πού άναφέρονται στήν άρχαια 'Ελλάδα, τούς έλληνιστικούς χρόνους, στό βυζαντιο, στή μεταβυζαντινή περίοδο και στή νεότερη 'Ελλάδα. Τό μεγαλύτερο ποσοστό διατριβών τής πρώτης ένότητας (1874 - 1950) άφορά τήν άρχαια 'Ελλάδα. 'Άλλα και γενικότερα, άν κοιτάζει κανείς τό σύνολο τών διατριβών γιά τίς έπιστημες τού 'Ανθρώπου πού έγκριθηκαν από 'Αγγλικά Πανεπιστήμια από τόν προηγούμενο αιώνα ώς τόν 'Β' Παγκόσμιο Πόλεμο, θά διαπιστώσει ότι ή 'Ελληνική άρχαιότητα και ή κλασική περίοδος παίζει πρωτεύοντα ρόλο ώς θεωρητικό άντικειμένο έρευνας και πηγή έμπνευσης και γνώσης. Η παρατήρηση αυτή άποτελεί άλλη μά έμπειρική ξνδειξη τής σημαντικής έπιδρασης τού έλληνικού πνεύματος στήν Εύρωπη. Οι ξένοι έρευνητές πήραν τήν άρχαια θεωρία και τήν έκαναν έπιστημονική πράξη. Είναι κρίμα πού στή σύγχρονη 'Ελλάδα ή πράξη αυτή δέν έχει καταφέρει νά ξεπεράσει (δόση μπορεί νά γενικεύει κανείς) τό έπιπεδο τής στείρας προγονολαγνείας. Σε σύνολο περίπου τετρακοσίων διατριβών τήν πρώτης ένότητας,

οι έρευνητές μέ έλληνικό δνομα μόλις ξεπερνούν τούς δέκα, και μόνο 13-15 διατριβές άσχολούνται μέ τή νεότερη 'Ελλάδα. Στή δεύτερη ένότητα (1950-1974) τό ύψηλό ποσοστό τής άρχαιας 'Ελλάδας διατηρείται άλλα βλέπουμε πώς έμφανίζονται περισσότερες διατριβές μέ άντικειμένο τή νεότερη 'Ελλάδα (102 σε σύνολο 650 περίπου).

Γενικότερα, γιά τό σύνολο και τών δύο ένοτήτων ππορούμε νά πούμε ότι, ποσοστιαία, μέ τήν 'Αρχαια 'Ελλάδα άσχολούνται περισσότεροι ξένοι έρευνητές ένω γιά τή νεότερη 'Ελλάδα τό μεγαλύτερο ποσοστό είναι 'Ελληνες. 'Ενα είδικο τμήμα συνολικά 40 περίπου διατριβών άναφέρεται στήν Κύπρο.

Γιά τήν πραγμάτωση τού δλον έργου, ίδιαίτερες εύχαριστίες δφείλονται στό Γραφείο Τύπου Λονδίνου πού άφεθηκε τόσο πρόθυμα νά πειστεί γιά τή χρησιμότητα τέτοιας έρευνας και τελικά νά τήν χρηματοδοτήσει. στόν Γιάννη Γιαννουλόποντο πού βοήθησε στήν ταξινόμηση τής πρώτης ένότητας, στήν Κάλλια Καλλιατάκη πού έπιμελήθηκε τών έλληνικών μον. και στήν άπαραίτητη «'Ελένη».

"Ομως, οι τελειωμένες διατριβές είναι ή μία δψη τού νομίσματος. Ή άλλη είναι οι καινούργιες. Πολλοί μεταπτυχιακοί φοιτητές, 'Ελληνες στήν πλειονότητά τους, συχνά ρωτούν τί θέμα θά μπορούσαν νά διαλέξουν στήν έρευνά τους. 'Αναφέρομαι έδω κυρίως στήν περίοδο τής νεότερης και σύγχρονης 'Ελλάδας. Χρειάζεται νομίζω ένας άδηγός πού νά έντοπίζει χώρους γνώσης σέ κάθε κλάδο δπου θά ήταν χρήσιμη ή έρευνα, τίς θεωρητικές και έμπειρικές πλευρές τού προτεινόμενον θέματος, τίς σχετικές εύρυτερες έπιστημονικές συζητήσεις στίς δποιες ή συγκεκριμένη έρευνα θά συνεισφέρει καθώς και τά θεωρητικά παρεπόμενα τής συνεισφοράς αύτης.

"Ένας τέτοιος άδηγός, πιθανόν μέ παράρτημα βασικής βιβλιογραφίας θά έδινε σέ φοιτητές και διδάσκοντες, 'Ελληνες και ξένους, χρήσιμους βασικούς προσανατολισμούς. Κάθε διατριβή άποτελεί ένα ξεκαθάρισμα. Καί στήν 'Ελλάδα χρειάζονται τόσα πολλά.



Τά Σ.Θ. δημοσιεύουν τή δουλειά τοῦ Ρούσσου Κούνδουρου γιά τούς έξης λόγους:

1. Γενικότεροι ένημερωτικής παιδευτικής φύσης λόγοι: Τό ένδιαφέρον πού παρουσιάζει ή άπλή παρακολούθηση τής θεματολογίας πού καλύφθηκε στό διάστημα τής τελευταίας έκαπονταετίας από ξένους κυρίως και ξληνες έρευνητές στήν 'Αγγλία και τήν 'Ιρλανδία. Κι' αυτό πέρα από τίς δυσκολίες πού συναντά κανείς στό νά συναγάγει συμπεράσματα ώς πρός τό πραγματικό περιεχόμενο και τήν έσωτερική δομή μᾶς έργασίας από τήν άπλή άναγνωση τών τίτλων.

2. Η συνειδητοποίηση από τό ύψηλό ποσοστό τών ξένων έρευνητών σέ σχέση μέ τούς έλαχιστους "Ελληνες, πώς μά διαδικασία πού σχετίζεται μέ τή γνώση τής ιστορίας μας, τής παράδοσης μας, τοῦ 'Ελληνικού Πολιτισμού και τοῦ Βυζαντινοῦ άλλά και τών νεότερων χρόνων περνάει άναγκαστικά μέσα από τή συστηματική μελέτη ξένων έρευνητών δχι μόνο στήν 'Αγγλία και τήν 'Ιρλανδία άλλά και σέ δλες τίς άναπτυγμένες χώρες Δυτικές και 'Ανατολικές. Μιά διαδικασία αιτογνωσίας δέν μπορεῖ νά είναι κλειστά έλλαδοκεντρική.

3. Η μελέτη τών έκφανσεων τοῦ Εύρωπαικοῦ Πολιτισμοῦ, στή φιλοσοφία, στίς έπιστημες, στίς τέχνες, στήν πολιτική δλων τών τάσεων και ρευμάτων, μᾶς οδηγεῖ μονόδρομα στόν 'Αρχαιο 'Ελληνικό Πολιτισμό σάν πυρήνα - κέντρο άναφορᾶς, πηγή έμπνευσης κι άνανέωσης τοῦ ίδιου τοῦ Εύρωπαικοῦ Πολιτισμοῦ.

'Η έλλαδοκεντρικότητα τοῦ Εύρωπαικοῦ Πολιτισμοῦ στοιχειοθετεῖται γιά τήν 'Αγγλία και τήν 'Ιρλανδία από τό ύψηλό ποσοστό διατριβών, στό σύνολο τών διατριβών πού κατατέθηκαν γιά τίς έπιστημες τοῦ άνθρώπου, τών έργασιών πού καταπιάνονται μέ τήν 'Ελληνική 'Αρχαιότητα και τήν κλασική περίοδο. 'Η ούσιαστική δημωργική μελέτη τής κλασικής περιόδου άντιπαρατίθεται στό

στείρο πνεύμα τής προγονολογίας, δπως τό άποκαλεῖ ό Ρούσσος Κούνδουρος, πού έπικρατεῖ στούς έκπαιδευτικούς μηχανισμούς στήν 'Ελλάδα.

4. Θεωρώντας άναγκαία τή γενίκευση αυτής τής δουλειάς σέ δλες τίς χώρες δπου ύπηρξε κάποια έρευνα και μελέτη τής έλληνικής πραγματικότητας (πολιτισμκής, ιστορικής, πολιτικής, οικονομκής), τά Σ.Θ. πιστεύουν πώς ή έργασία τοῦ P. Κούνδουρου θά μποροῦσε ν' άποτελέσει ένα ένανσμα.

5. Μεσο-μακροπρόθεσμα μπαίνει τό σημαντικό πρόβλημα

(a) Τής μελέτης τών έργασιών και τής σοδαρής θεματολογικής κατανομῆς.

(b) Τής κριτικής άξιολόγησης κατά θεματολογική δύμαδα τής δουλειάς πού έχει γίνει μέχρι σήμερα σέ δλες τίς χώρες.

6. Βασική προϋπόθεση γιά τήν ούσιαστική ένημέρωση και τό σωστό προσανατολισμό τών νέων έρευνητών τού τί έχει γίνει σέ κάθε τομέα και τοῦ τί δέν έχει γίνει: Συχνά έμφανίζεται τό πρόβλημα σέ νέους μελετητές τοῦ προσδιορισμοῦ πεδίων θεωρητικής η έμπειρικής έρευνας.

7. Τέτοιες πρωτοβουλίες δέν μποροῦν νά είναι άποκλειστικά ύπόθεση άτόμων: Πρέπει νά ύπάρξει συντονισμένη, συλλογική έργασία μέ τή σημαντική ένίσχυση έρευνητών απ' τό έλληνικό κράτος.

Καί γι' αυτό πρέπει δλες οι φωτισμένες και ούσιαστικά προοδευτικές δυνάμεις άνεξάρτητα πολιτικής ένταξης νά πιέσουν στήν κατεύθυνση άναληψης τέτοιων κρίσιμων πρωτοβουλιών απ' τό έλληνικό κράτος σάν βασική προϋπόθεση τής άπαρχης μᾶς πορείας «κατάκτησης» δλων τών στοιχείων και γνώσεων, πού σχετίζονται μέ τή γνώση τών καταβολών μας, τής παράδοσης μας άλλα και τών σύγχρονων δεδομένων πού συνιστούν τή σημερινή έλληνική πραγματικότητα.
